WHO WE ARE: SP Recycling Corporation, a wholly owned subsidiary of SP Newsprint Co., LLC, is responsible for the company's fiber procurement, specifically to create recycled newsprint from old newspapers. Our mills are located in Dublin, Georgia, and Newberg, Oregon.

SPRC purchases paper through its ten Florida Divisions and its other 27 processing-facilities in 12 states by offering collection containers for community and non-profit group fundraising. The recovered paper is then collected, processed and shipped to the mill for recycling.

RECYCLING WITH SP RECYCLING IS ABSOLUTELY FREE. There has never been a charge and we always pay for the paper. Step-by-step *EASY* instructions for *GETTING GREEN* from paper recycling are provided by SP Recycling

THERE IS A MINIMUM COLLECTION REQUIREMENT PER MONTH TO QUALIFY FOR THE PROGRAM DEPENDING ON THE SIZE OF CONTAINER AND LOCATION

To give you some weight perspective: if a family saves the newspaper everyday for a month they would save about 50 pounds of newspaper. So, 200 families, saving the daily newspaper, have the potential of generating 10,000 pounds per month. Of course, not everyone recycles, yet! Out of 200 families, you are likely to get 40 to 60 percent participation resulting in a range of 4,000 to 6,000 pounds.



THE COLLECTION OF DONATED PAPER CAN BE ONE OF THE EASIEST, MOST SUCCESSFUL WAYS OF EARNING MONEY FOR YOUR GROUP. AND, the keys to a successful paper collection program are organization and promotion to get the goal volume you desire. Pricing starts at \$15 per ton and depends on the volume collected monthly.

Step 1 - GET STARTED TODAY BY CONTACTING SP. Learn how much you can earn and how SP Recycling will work to make your program a success.

Step 2 - SELECT YOUR RECYCLING COORDINATOR! This should be a person you can count on to produce the best results. Your coordinator will maintain contact with SP Recycling Corporation and will be responsible for scheduling container service, rounding up volunteers and promoting your program. Choose a

detail-oriented, motivated individual who enjoys dealing with people and getting things done!

Step 3 - SECURE NEEDED PERMISSION

Secure the permission / approval of the principal decision maker(s). Provide the reasons for your newspaper collection program. Ex: (a) raise funds for your group, (b) environmental stewardship (c) community service.

Step 4 - CHOOSE A COLLECTION SITE

The collection site you choose should be centrally located and highly visible to draw as many local residents as possible. It should provide easy access and departure for a smooth flow of traffic, as well as, pick up by an SP Recycling truck. A fenced or paved area with sufficient space, such as a school, church or supermarket parking area is ideal. *Take care to keep your containers away from areas where garbage is dumped!*

The bin size varies depending on your location and amount of material generated. Most bins can fit into one parking space. No low branches or wires.

Step 5 - ARRANGE FOR HELPING HANDS

Volunteers play an important role in making your newspaper collection program a success. Enthusiastic volunteers are invaluable – from promotion to event coordination.

Step 6 - TELL EVERYONE ABOUT IT!

The more people who know about your recycling program, the more people will recycle!

Container Agreement Form

SP Recycling Corporation (SPRC) is providing a Recycling Container at your location at no charge in exchange for NEWSPAPER, Magazines, Catalogs, White Office Paper, and Shredded Paper collected by your organization.

SPRC will pick up the recyclables at no charge to you and will pay you quarterly for the tonnages collected. No payments can be made on contaminated loads (ex: cans, bottles or other garbage) since such loads must be land-filled. SPRC will work with you to develop a successful recycling program with how to tips, marketing suggestions and website information.

This agreement will be for 1 (one) year from the signed date and will automatically renew each additional year unless terminated by either party within 30 days by verbal or written notice.
